12th International Conference on Greek Linguistics (ICGL12)

The Chair for Modern Greek Studies and the Center for Modern Greece (CeMoG), both at the Freie Universität Berlin (FU Berlin), are pleased to announce the 12th International Conference on Greek Linguistics (ICGL12). The International Conference on Greek Linguistics is a biennial meeting on the study and analysis of Greek (Ancient, Medieval and Modern), placing particular emphasis on the later stages of the language. ICGL12 will take place at the Seminarzentrum of the FU (Otto-von-Simson-Str. 26, 14195 Berlin, Germany) from **16 to 19 September 2015**.

Papers in all areas of linguistic analysis (applied linguistics, computational linguistics, conversation analysis, corpus linguistics, dialectology, discourse analysis, historical linguistics, morphology, neurolinguistics, phonetics, phonology, pragmatics, psycholinguistics, semantics, sociolinguistics, syntax, etc.) focusing on any period in the history of the Greek language are welcome.

The Conference will also host a small number of thematic workshops (up to six) and a poster session.

A. Abstract Submission for oral or written presentations

Abstracts for oral presentations (20' for the paper and 10' for discussion) or posters (written presentations) on any aspect of the Greek language are invited. Abstracts should be 300-400 words long (exclusive of references) and should be submitted in Word (.doc, .docx or .rtf format) through EasyChair (see below) by **January 31, 2015**. Notifications of acceptance/rejection will be communicated by February 28, 2015.

Please also include the following information at the bottom of the abstract:

1. Name(s) of author(s)
2. Title
3. Affiliation
4. Area of linguistics (e.g. phonology, morphology, syntax, historical linguistics, etc.)
5. Oral presentation or poster

Each author may maximally submit two abstracts: EITHER one single-authored and one co-authored OR two co-authored abstracts.

B. Abstract Submission for thematic workshops

Workshop proposals on any research area in Greek linguistics are welcome. Abstracts of 400-500 words (exclusive of references) in Word (.doc, .docx or .rtf format) should be submitted through EasyChair (see below) by **December 31, 2014**. Notifications of acceptance/rejection will be communicated by January 31, 2015.

Please also include the following information at the bottom of the abstract:

1. Name(s) of author(s)
2. Title of the thematic workshop
3. Affiliation
4. Area of linguistics (e.g. phonology, morphology, syntax, historical linguistics, etc.)

EasyChair instructions for Authors

The submission and review of papers for the ICGL12 will be managed through an online conference paper management system called "EasyChair" (www.easychair.org). This system gives you, the author, complete control over your submission. You can upload your abstract and check the review status of your submission. Therefore, all authors need to create an Easy Chair account. The paper and workshop proposals will be reviewed by the members of the Scientific Committee.

How to submit your abstract

1. Go to the EasyICGL12: <https://easychair.org/conferences/?conf=icgl12>
2. Create an EasyChair account (if you don't have any)
3. Login to the ICGL12 submission page.
3. Click on the "New Submission" link at the top of the screen.
3. Follow the instructions on the submission form, fill in your abstract and all requested information, and then click on the "Submit" button at the bottom of the form.
 - Write "N/A" in the text boxes that do not apply in your case (e.g. "Fax").
 - At least one author and two keywords are required.
 - Please write at least two lines in the "Abstract", and upload your actual abstract in the Paper upload box.
4. Click on the "Submit Paper" button.
5. Submitted abstracts can be modified, up to the final deadline, by logging in and clicking "My submissions". The menu on the right will assist you with submission modification.
