2016 GRADUATE RESEARCH COLLOQUIUM IN MODERN GREEK STUDIES

CALL FOR PAPERS

The 2016 Graduate Research Colloquium will take place at the Faculty of Classics (Room G.21), Sidgwick Avenue, Cambridge, on **Thursday 16 June**, from 10:30 am until about 6:00 pm. Contributions may be in any area of Modern Greek Studies, including literature, history, linguistics, anthropology, art history, media studies etc., or they may be of an interdisciplinary nature.

Submissions are invited from registered graduate students (MA, MPhil, MPhil(b), MRes, PhD, DPhil) at UK universities. Visiting students from other countries may also be considered if there is room in the programme; they should enquire before submitting an abstract. Applicants need to be a current member of the Society for Modern Greek Studies; if not already a member, they should join via the website <http://www.moderngreek.org.uk/society/join>

Papers should be in English and should on no account exceed 20 minutes. There will be a maximum of 12 speakers, with questions and discussion at the end of each session. Proposals, including a title and abstract of 150-200 words, should be sent as an email attachment to Professor David Holton, dwh11@cam.ac.uk, to arrive by **Monday 18 April 2016** at the latest. Please indicate the degree for which you are registered, your university, and the name and email of your supervisor. Please include both your postal address and email. Those who submit proposals will be notified by **Monday 2 May** whether their submissions have been accepted. Speakers receive a free buffet lunch and reimbursement of their travel expenses (if their own institution is unable to cover them) up to a maximum of £50.00.
